Apply For VPK!

Florida's Voluntary Prekindergarten Education Program, (VPK) is a free educational program that prepares 4-year-olds for success in kindergarten and beyond. Children must live in Florida and be 4 on or before Sept. 1 of the school year they enroll.

Parents whose children are born between Feb. 2 and Sept. 1 of the calendar year may postpone enrolling their 4-year-old until the following year when their child is 5.

To apply:

Visit the <u>Family Portal</u> and choose "Apply for Voluntary Prekindergarten" Complete application accordingly. You will receive status updates via e-mail. *To access via our website – visit www.elcfv.org and click "Apply Now"

Date of Birth verification (*please upload one of the following documents*): Certified copy of birth certificate, shot record, passport, baptisms certificate, military I.D., mature life insurance policy of at least 2 years.

Residency Verification (please upload one of the following documents): Valid driver's



license with current physical address OR utility bill OR pay stub OR lease government issued item, property tax assessment w/homestead exemption.

Once your application has been submitted, ELC staff will review. You will receive email notifications regarding the status of your application. Once approved, you will provide a copy of your VPK certificate to an approved VPK provider.

Florida Bureau of Braille and Talking Book Library

The Florida Braille and Talking Book Library is a Bureau of the Florida Division of Blind Services within the Florida Department of Education. The Library works in cooperation with the nation-wide network of the National Library Service for the Blind and Print Disabled (Library of Congress) to provide services throughout the state.

The Library is dedicated to reaching all eligible Floridians with our specialized services. Anyone unable to access standard print due to vision loss, blindness, a physical disability, or a certifiable reading disability may be eligible for the Library's free services.

The Braille and Talking Book Library provides books and magazines in Braille and audio formats, and the long-term loan of playback equipment, free of charge, to qualified individuals of any age. Materials are sent and returned through the U. S. Postal Service, at no cost to the user, and they may be downloaded from the National Library Service website. Special players are also available for individuals with hearing loss.
