The Community Agenda initiative is а engagement process to



examine data and establish priorities to improve local health and human services in Flagler and Volusia Counties. The ninth annual updated Community Agenda Snapshot report is available at www.agendavf.org. In 2015 we distributed 250 flash drives with this and other vital community data to our stakeholders and we recorded 51,130 overall access visits in 2014.

The thrive by five Collaborative is an initiative of the Community Agenda. Member organizations meet regularly improve the early childhood system



care for prenatal through age five years and their families.

81% of our youth who do drink do so in their home or a friend's*. Parents Who Host Lose the Most is a vital campaign to addresses the repercussions of parent hosting..

DJJ reported Volusia County had 40.6 reports of delinquency per 1,000 youth, with the state comparatively having 27.4 per 1,000 youth in 2013. It is time for our youth and parents to Know the Law, a powerful 1 hour training and take home booklet that prevents delinquency now available to 7,000 of our youth and their families.

In a given 30 day period, almost 80% of Volusia County youth reported that they did not use drugs or alcohol and 81% of or youth who received A's and B;s reported NEVER using substances*. Youth who feel that their community supports them are less likely to engage in substance abuse. The *Friday Night Done Right* social norming campaign gives youth the real data coupled with opportunities to be with their peers in positive substance free environments.
